## Top 10 Reasons Photographers Miss Shots

- 1 Access to your camera must be quick. It's crucial you have a camera bag that allows easy, fast access to your camera.
- 2 Make certain that you have more than one fully charged battery before you set out on a photography trip.
- 3 Ensure that you clean the front and rear of your lenses to reduce spots.
- 4 Make absolutely certain that you have enough storage capacity on your camera and its additional memory cards.
- 5 Ensure that your camera is preset to the settings you require for the subject you're going to shoot.
- 6 If your camera is equipped with image stabilization technology or vibration reduction, use it correctly. If you're tripod shooting, turn them off to ensure sharper images.
- 7 Ensure you have fitted any filters prior to heading out on a shoot.
- 8 Make sure you have taken your lens cap off!
- 9 Make sure your camera is switched on in anticipation of capturing an image.
- 10 Don't look at images on your LCD and revel in excellence. Do a quick check to ascertain settings are correct, then move on to the next shot.

To show digital images at their best, and to show them at the new sizes coming into force from January 2016 it became necessary to replace the club's projector.

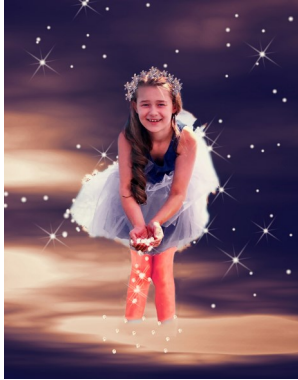
