Excerpts from John Stewart's News Letter 7 December 2014

As most of you will know, Wendy stepped down as President at the conclusion of final night and as Vice I have had to step up for the 2015 year (remember that our AGM is now late in 2015). Thank you Wendy for all that you did in 2014.

PSNZ/Interclub News

PSNZ have done another change to the interclub competitions with both the Bledisloe (prints) and Wiltshire (digital) now having to be a "themed set" of four images each from four individual photographers. This has been given a low profile by PSNZ (even their own website still reflects the old entry rules), with the only comment I can see being a couple of lines in the September/October Camerataalk.

The Wiltshire has also changed to be the same as the Bledisloe with a straight entry, no longer a preliminary round at the regionals with the top four clubs from each region competing in the national final.

Entry for both competitions close in mid-February and, as it is hard enough to select a "selection" as opposed to a "themed set" we may look at sitting out 2015 and spend the year working on "sets" for 2016, selecting them late in 2015. but that decision is ultimately up to committee and the interclub selection panel.

Set yourself a photo task for the holiday season

At the start of 2011 I set myself a personal project of taking at least one photo a day and posting it to the internet (I posted mine to my Flickr site). But events that happened in February that year meant that photography was not a major objective in my life, so I abandoned that personal project part way through. I did however attempt it again in 2013 and completed it. A couple of days I got to near mid-night before realizing that I hadn't taken my daily shot - they should be self evident in my photos! While I don't want you to do something like this (unless you want to have a go in 2015) set yourself a minor project to do over the holidays. Here are a few suggestions:

A photo a day for a week, each one a different genre (landscape, portrait, natural history, table top, P J etc)

A 26 image set representing the alphabet (apple, bee, car etc)

Shoot a series of images at a fixed focal length (eg 50mm) and let your legs be your "zoom"

Do a series of images on a subject you don't normally shoot

Shoot some abstract images in black & white - look for shapes, lines, shadows etc

Depict Christmas (decorations, Christmas tree, Christmas dinner etc) but not a straight "record shot". John Stewart LPSNZ
