An award in the Highland Trophy does not count towards the member's total End of Year score.

END OF YEAR COMPETITIONS

A member must have entered a minimum of 3 club competitions in any medium in the current club calendar year to be eligible for End of Year competitions in that medium.

Only those entries which won an award can be entered.

An image can be entered at the End of Year competition in a different category than that in which it originally won an award.

Images are not considered in separate grades for this end of year competition.

End of Year Categories are Natural History, Portrait, Photo-Journalism, Landscape, and Open .

Up to 3 images in each category and in each medium may be entered.

Field Trip Competition

Images that have been taken during the current year, that have been shown or not shown, or those that have been entered during the year whether they received an award or not.

The entry form must include the location, the date the image was taken and the occasion.

C Grade Un-Shown Competition

A maximum of 3 previously unseen images may be entered in any or all media. Entries in this competition, whether successful or not, can be entered in subsequent competitions.

Entries in the Highland Trophy can also be entered in this competition.

Black and White Competition

For the purpose of this competition, the term "Black and White" is synonymous with the term "monochrome", which means that an image entered in this competition will contain only shades of grey or of a single colour e.g. sepia or any other single colour.

A maximum of three entries in each of the three media may be entered. Prints may be trade processed.

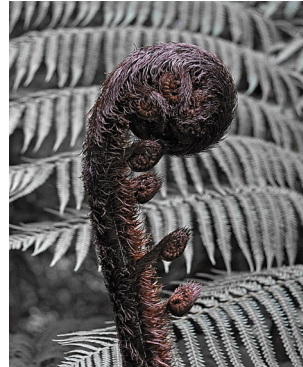

Some tips for making an Audio Visual (AV)

Use Windows Movie Maker, or download free slideshow software from the internet. Alternatively there are programs you can buy, e.g. ProShow Gold, Movie Maker, Pictures ToExe, CyberLink Media Show and so forth. Some of you may already have one of these programs.

- 1 Before you begin work out the type of AV you want to make.
- 2 Gather together all the images you are going to use into one place.
- 3 Find the appropriate music you want to use.
- 4 Drag and drop, or import the images and music file into the program you are using.
- 5 Make a title slide.
- 6 Arrange the images into the order you want to show them.
- 7 Add the transitions you want to use between images.
- 8 Add the music file.
- 9 Make an ending slide for the credits.

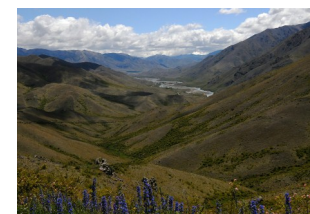

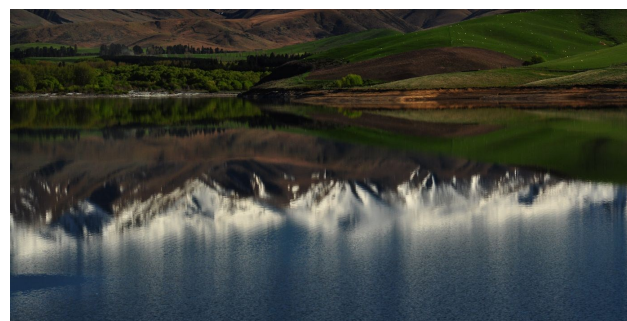

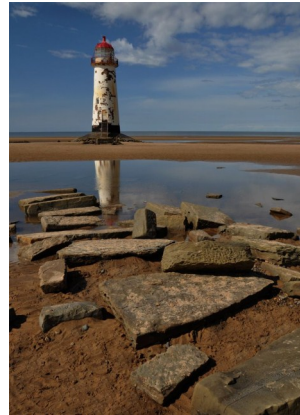
